MIKE FOSTER Hand Wrist and Elbow Surgeon Elbow Arthroscopy

Problem

- Pain and discomfort in the elbow, usually with associated locking symptoms.

Cause

- Inflammation in the elbow joint, synovitis.
- Loose pieces of bone causing locking type symptoms.
- Bony spurs leading to impingement.

Diagnosis

- Pain and discomfort that localises to the elbow, history of the joint locking.
- Plain x-rays normally alert one to the diagnosis of a joint issue.
- MR scans useful to look for synovitis.
- CT scan useful to look for loose bodies and bony spurs.

Treatment

- Surgical
- Small portals are made around the elbow.
- Small camera used to look into the elbow joint.
- Small instruments used to debride synovitis and bone spurs.
- Loose bodies can sometimes be removed arthroscopically or may require a mini open approach.

Potential Complications

- Infection, haematoma, neurovascular injury.

Post Op Care

- Padded crepe
- Hand therapy
